

Medicare Mandatory Insurer Reporting (MIR)



If you are a self-insured Fund who is either self-administered or is utilizing the services of a TPA or Carrier ASO, Medicare now requires that your Fund electronically submit information on individuals who are eligible to receive benefits under your Fund's health plan.

***Do not assume that your TPA or Carrier is doing this for you.
It is ultimately your Fund's responsibility, with penalties for non-compliance.***

This electronic submission is the new mandatory secondary payor reporting requirement for group health plans imposed by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). Beginning as early as January 1, 2009, administrators of self-insured group health plans will be required to submit enrollment information on plan participants.

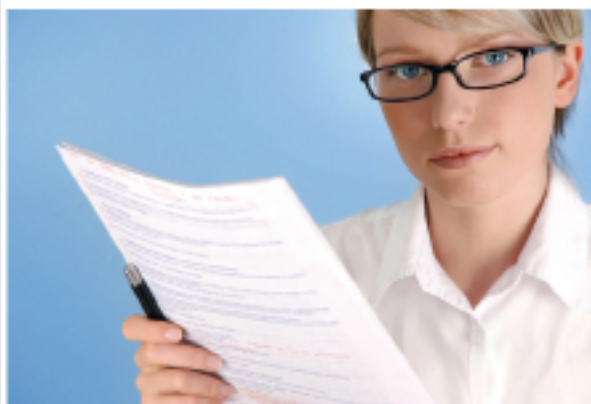
